**Carol "Rollie" Flynn
President of the Foreign Policy Research Institute**

Carol "Rollie" Flynn is the President of the Foreign Policy Research Institute (FPRI), a nonpartisan think tank based in Philadelphia which produces nonpartisan policy analysis focused on crucial foreign policy and national security challenges facing the United States. FPRI also publishes *Orbis*, a quarterly journal of international affairs. Ms. Flynn has been a Senior Fellow at FPRI since 2015 and in this capacity has written and spoken on topics that include national security, the Intelligence Community, and counterterrorism.

Ms. Flynn is a 30-year veteran of the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) where she held senior executive positions including Director of the CIA's Leadership Academy, Associate Deputy Director of the National Counterterrorism Center, Executive Director of the CIA Counterterrorism Center, and Director of the Office of Foreign Intelligence Relationships, and leadership positions in the CIA's Africa Division. She also has extensive overseas experience including as Chief of Station in major posts in Southeast Asia and Latin America, and as an undercover Clandestine Operations Officer in Africa and Southeast Asia. While at the CIA, she rose to the rank of SIS-04, the equivalent of a three-star general.

Ms. Flynn is also the founder Singa Consulting, LLC and previously served as its Managing Principal. Singa is a professional services firm that provides security, cyber security, leadership development and executive coaching, and training services to the private sector and government.

She is currently the President of the Foreign Policy Research Institute, founded in 1955 and located in Philadelphia. The Institute provides the highest quality scholarship and nonpartisan policy analysis focused on crucial foreign policy and national challenges facing the United States.
